MSc Studentship in Cardiovascular Genetics

About the Studentship

Suitably qualified candidates are invited to apply for a fully funded MSc in the Cardiovascular Genetics Laboratory in the Department of Medicine, at the University of Cape Town. The MSc studentship will form part of a larger study (IMHOTEP) where the aim is to identify the causative genes in cases affected with the various forms of heart disease, including those that target the structure and rhythm of the heart, ultimately leading to sudden cardiac death or requiring heart transplants.

The project

Cardiomyopathy contributes to 20-30% of heart failure in adults in the African population and in Sub-Saharan Africa, it is ranked as the third largest contributor to the burden of cardiovascular disease, after stroke and ischaemic heart disease. This study provides an opportunity to study a range of different types of familial and sporadic cardiomyopathies. Genetic cardiomyopathies warrant close study because they are often present in younger individuals and are a major cause of mortality and morbidity in this age group.

Requirements

- The ideal candidates must preferably have a strong academic background in the fields of molecular biology and/or genetics.
- Required academic qualifications include an Honours in Molecular Biology/Genetics/related field. Equivalent qualifications may also be accepted.
- The candidates must possess good writing skills in English (as evidence by prior publication or thesis). Applicants whose first language is not English should note that English language proficiency is also required.

Application process

All applications should include (1) a motivation letter (2 pages maximum); (2) a full curriculum vitae and (3) letters of reference from at least two academics who have taught, supervised or worked alongside the applicant during their university training.
