Today at the ESC during the **Late Breaking Clinical Science: Global Insights and Outcomes session**, the most recent findings of the Thesus-HF II study were presented to our global colleagues. The presentation was very well received, as it shed light on underrepresented countries, contributing to a more truly global understanding of Acute Heart Failure (AHF). Our colleagues expressed admiration for the remarkably high treatment uptake demonstrated in the data. 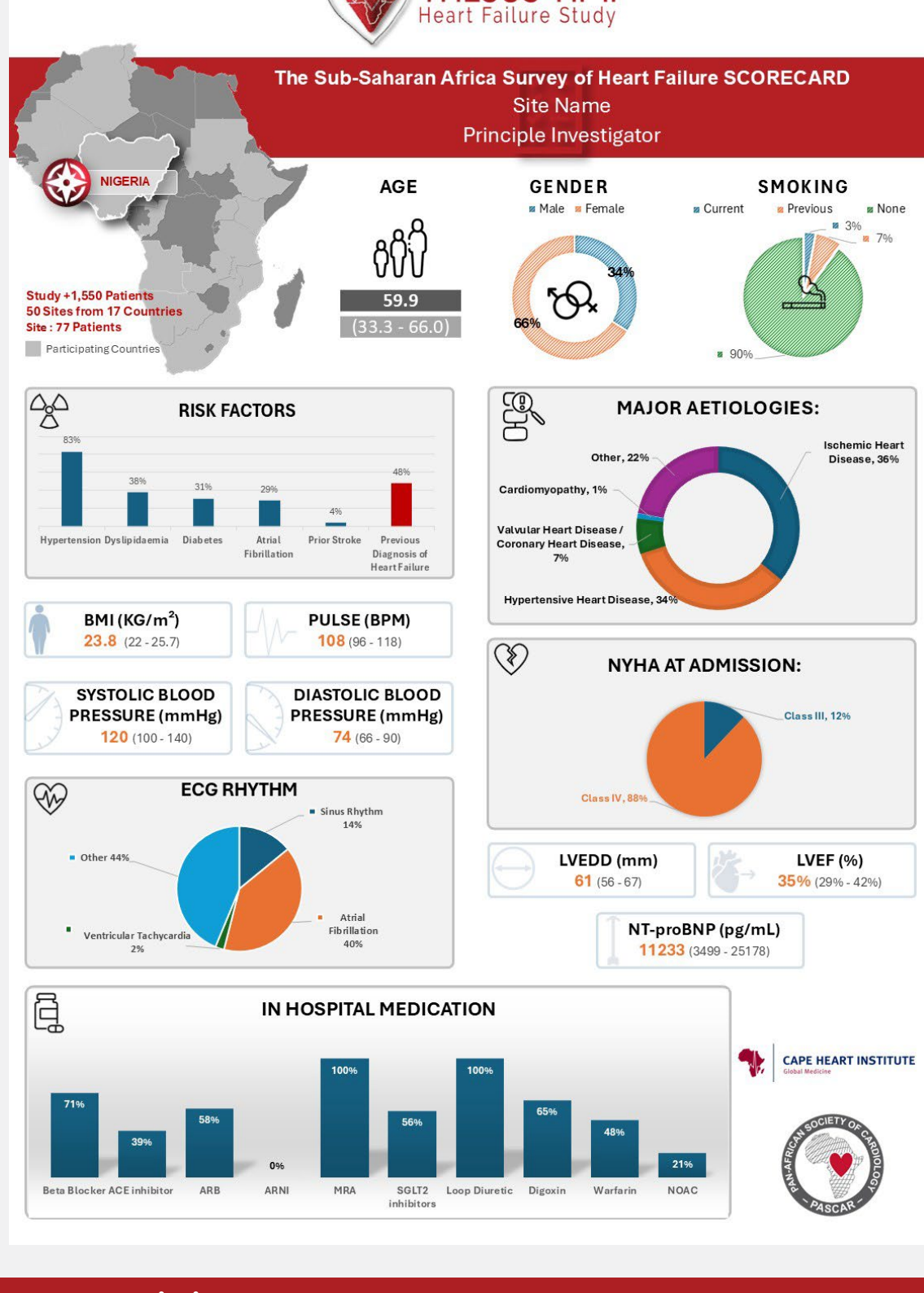
